CONSULTANT OF THE MONTH – PETER WALKER



I am a Consultant Clinical Psychologist with 20 years post-qualification experience. My clinical experience lies within the areas of older adult mental health, adult and youth offending and child and adolescent mental health. I am also trained as a Cognitive Analytic Therapist and my preferred modes of therapy are relational and psychodynamic approaches to treatment. I have additional training in adult Neuropsychology.

CLINICAL PRACTICE: I run a small therapy practice one day per week in which I offer clients treatments such as Cognitive Analytic Therapy. Other treatments can include Cognitive Behaviour Therapy and as a Clinical Psychologist, I am trained to integrate the concepts from a range of psychological models (e.g. psychodynamic, systemic etc.).

EXPERT WITNESS: Most of my practice is taken up with expert witness work in the Family, Civil and Criminal Court. This involves comprehensive assessments of adults, children and families using a range of assessment methodologies such as interview, child-friendly assessment methods (e.g., play, drawing, stories), psychometric assessment and observation. It also involves me attending Court to provide oral evidence on the assessment reports and to be cross examined.

TEACHING AND TRAINING: I am also available to provide bespoke training on psychological issues to organisations. Examples of training topics can range across issues such as psychological formulation, psychological approaches to personality disorder, child development and offending risk.
